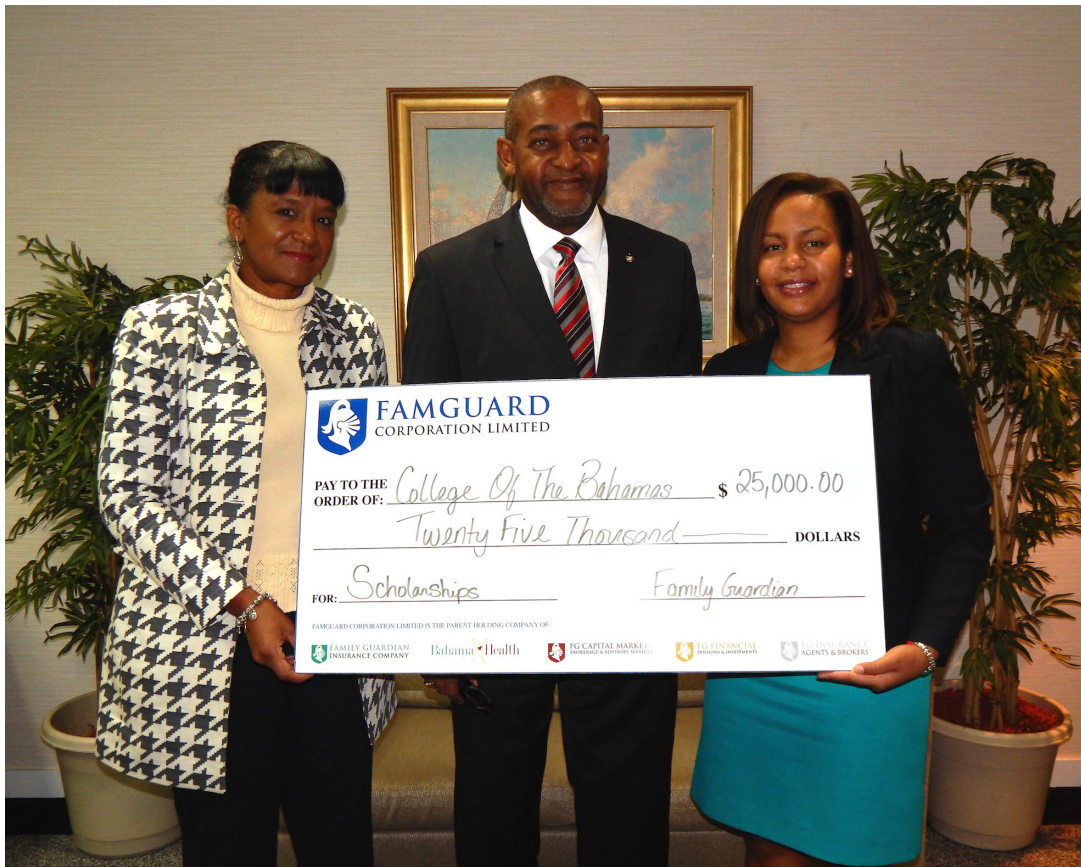




Family Guardian Continues To Support Higher Education In The Bahamas
